Some of the many tips

- PDFs in Preview can be edited, the file format can be changed and you can colour edit like in iPhoto
- too many icons on desktop will slow down the machine
- apple H - hides what is on the desktop
- apple Tab - cycle through open applications
- apple click - changes background
  - check out album art as a screen saver
- shift command 4 gives you a screen shot
- Capture Me is a free program that does the same thing
- when you travel and access different networks, make sure to delete them upon returning

- check out Missing Manuals at Chapters
- Mac AppsStorm some useful apps here
- when searching in Google use "" if you have 2 or more words in the search
